

WIL Digital helps students develop the skills needed to enter and succeed in the workforce.


Eligible students can be supported with a wage subsidy of up to 50% of their salary, with underrepresented students qualifying for up to 70% coverage.

- Secure a work placement with an eligible business and have your employer begin the application on the <u>etalentcanada.ca</u> website.
- Eligible students must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or be registered as having refugee status in Canada and enrolled in a Canadian-accredited post-secondary institution.
